Presentation Formats

Selection Criteria

All abstracts will be considered based on the information in the submission and will be assessed according to the following criteria:

- Originality of the work
- Quality of the abstract, including a clear connection between the issue being addressed, the work undertaken, the outcomes of the work and implications for the profession.
- Priority will be given to submissions that present original work, link to evidence, and demonstrate innovation and critical thinking.
