

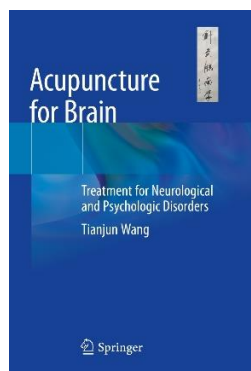
Prof. Dr. Tianjun Wang

Principal of London Academy of Chinese Acupuncture (LACA)

Guest Professor of Nanjing University of Chinese Medicine

Dr. Tianjun Wang graduated from Nanjing University of Chinese Medicine (NUCM) in 1989. He completed his PhD of Acupuncture at NUCM. Tianjun moved to the UK and joined the University of East London UK as a Senior Lecturer and the Director of Acupuncture Clinic 2007- 2014. He is a Guest Professor of NUCM. Current Prof. Wang is the Principal of the London Academy of Chinese Acupuncture (LACA). Prof. Wang is also the Vice President of the Scalp Acupuncture Committee of World Federation of Chinese Medicine Societies (WFCMS) and the president of the Institute of Scalp Acupuncture UK (ISA). He owns TJAcupuncture Clinic and Brain Care Centre in London.

Prof. Wang has authored and co-authored more than 50 academic papers as well as peer reviewers to many international journals. His authored book “Acupuncture for Brain: Treatment for Neurological and Psychologic Disorders” published by Springer 2020.



Talk title: Acupuncture not only good for pain—how to treat neurological conditions?

Traditional acupuncture is mostly used to treating pain conditions, it has helped plenty of people. Neurological diseases (ND) are not commonly treated in most acupuncture clinics in the Western, but the patients are a lot, such as stroke, brain trauma injury, Parkinson's disease, dementia, multiple sclerosis, cerebral palsy, etc. How to treat this kind of neurological diseases is a challenge for many acupuncturists.

During the presentation, Prof. Wang will introduce the brief knowledge of ND from the aspect of TCM and western medicine, the general acupuncture treatment for ND, particularly the unique scalp acupuncture for neurological conditions, with some special case studies.
