We invite you to join us over this weekend to connect with colleagues in person and share your skills and knowledge. We are planning a conference that has plenty of educational and practical sessions to inspire.

Abstracts are invited from all the branches of Chinese medicine - acupuncture, Chinese herbal medicine, Tuina, and Qi gong practitioners, allied and mainstream clinicians and academics under the conference theme *Connection and Community*. Presentations may relate to all areas of clinical and professional practice, education or research.

# Guide for authors/presenters

The deadline to submit abstracts is 17th March 2023

To submit your abstract, please email your completed abstract to <a href="mailto:nzra@acupuncture.org.nz">nzra@acupuncture.org.nz</a> The word limit for the abstract is 300 words and it will appear in the programme book as submitted.

#### **Presentation Formats**

There are two presentation formats to choose from:

## • Workshop presentations

Workshops encourage active involvement of participants. The workshop should be designed as an interactive session with specific objectives related to one or more of the conference themes. Workshops can run for 60, 90 or 180 minutes (3 hours).

Workshop abstracts should be structured as follows: Background, Objectives, Workshop format, and Expected outcomes. Maximum 300 words.

## • Oral Presentations

Oral presentations have the duration of 30 or 60 minutes.

Presentations will consist of either: 20 minutes for your presentation, 5 minutes for questions and 5 minutes to allow for a change of speakers. Or

45 minutes for your presentation, 10 minutes for questions and 5 minutes to allow for a change of speakers.

After the 25 / 55 minutes, the "Time-Keeper" in the room will ask the presenter to conclude the talk.



## Selection Criteria

All abstracts will be considered based on the information in the submission and will be assessed according to the following criteria:

- Relevance to the conference themes and objectives
- Originality of the work
- Quality of the abstract, including a clear connection between the issue being addressed, the work undertaken, the outcomes of the work and implications for the profession
- Priority will be given to submissions that present original work, link to evidence, and demonstrate innovation and critical thinking.

**NOTE:** Abstracts promoting commercial products or services will not be accepted.
