Membership Application Fee

A one-off non-refundable application fee is required on application for all Full/Practising members.

Graduate members. Those Graduates who have been Student members of Acupuncture NZ for one year or more will not have to pay the \$125.00 application fee when it comes time to move to Full/practising membership after graduation.

Annual Membership Fee

Fees cover the year from April 1 to March 31. For those joining throughout the year, fees are calculated according to the number of months of the financial year remaining.

***Graduates:** A reduced Annual Membership fee applies for Graduates who have completed the full programme an approved New Zealand school. This applies to the first 24 months of membership. After this the Graduate members move to the Full membership fee.

Associate Membership: Associate membership is for those members who are not currently practising but wish to retain membership of the organisation.

Academic Associate: Are those who are employed in an Acupuncture NZ recognised TCM teaching institution and not in private practice.

Student Membership: Is Free. A library fee of \$60 to cover postage and borrowing charges is required if a student member wishes to access the AcNZ library. Any residual amount will be refunded or credited against first year fees. For students moving into the practical clinical part of their course Acupuncture NZ offers a group insurance package.
